This 10-week, recognized manufacturing apprenticeship preparation program is currently offered at various locations in Western Washington.

Benefits of Apprenticeship Preparation

Apprenticeship Preparation provides students with basic foundational skills to find gainful entry-level employment. Students may meet the minimum qualifications to pursue additional career pathways in advanced manufacturing through AJAC's portfolio of registered apprenticeship programs.

Enrollment Requirements

Prior to enrollment in MA, AJAC requires students to complete a two-day workshop—Advanced Manufacturing Prep (AMP)—to help job seekers navigate the various career pathways into industry.

Upon completion, AJAC makes recommendations to each student on how they can achieve their career goals and the pathways best suited to each individual.
