To qualify for this job you will need to meet these requirements:

- Able to climb on ladders, operate forklifts, and utilize hand tools like screwdrivers and wrenches.
- Be at least 17 years old.
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent.
- Authorized to work in the U.S.

Ideal candidates will have:

A good attitude about work; good attention to detail; ability to follow verbal and written directions; ability to remember; able to show organizational and planning skills; problem-solving skills; successful work experience in a team environment, and good references. Be leadership minded, an independent thinker, have an ability to interface with all other disciplines within the organization including internal & external customers.

Work is primarily performed in a shop environment. There will be constant exposure to dust, odors, oil, fumes and noise. Includes exposure to outside elements when traveling between buildings. The first six months may include various shop-helper duties before the program begins in earnest.

Starting standard days and hours of work are Monday through Friday from 7am-3:30pm. The position may require the ability to report to work outside normal business hours when the need arises.
